AGREED TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

ON THIS DAY the State of Texas, by and through Texas Attorney General Greg Abbott, presented to the Court its application for temporary injunction. Defendant appeared through counsel. The Court, having considered the contents of Plaintiff's petition, and after hearing the evidence and argument of counsel, is of the opinion that the temporary injunction should be granted.

I.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Defendant, Eric Solis, and his officers, agents, employees, and those in concert or participation with them, are temporarily enjoined from subdividing, advertising, and selling property in violation of TEX. LOCAL GOV'T CODE, Chapter 232, Subchapter B.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this case is set for trial on the merits on the 18th day of May, 2006.
