#### **COUNT 3**

#### **MARIA GONZALEZ**

on or about March 7, 2006, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County of Hidalgo, State of Texas, did then and there, without the consent of the voter, knowingly possess an official ballot or official carrier envelope provided under the Texas Election Code to Transita Montemayor for the purpose of voting by mail in the March 2006 Primary Election,

**COUNT 4**

**MARIA GONZALEZ**

on or about March 7, 2006, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County of Hidalgo, State of Texas, did then and there, without the consent of the voter, knowingly possess an official ballot or official carrier envelope provided under the Texas Election Code to Elie Perez for the purpose of voting by mail in the March 2006 Primary Election,

**COUNT 5**

**MARIA GONZALEZ**

on or about March 7, 2006, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County of Hidalgo, State of Texas, did then and there, without the consent of the voter, knowingly possess an official ballot or official carrier envelope provided under the Texas Election Code to Iginio Espinoza for the purpose of voting by mail in the March 2006 Primary Election,
