on or about March 7, 2006, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County of Hidalgo, State of Texas, did then and there, without the consent of the voter, knowingly possess an official ballot or official carrier envelope provided under the Texas Election Code to Cleotilde Mendoza for the purpose of voting by mail in the March 2006 Primary Election,

COUNT 3

ORALIA FRAUSTO

on or about March 7, 2006, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County of Hidalgo, State of Texas, did then and there, without the consent of the voter, knowingly possess an official ballot or official carrier envelope provided under the Texas Election Code to Ivan Navarro for the purpose of voting by mail in the March 2006 Primary Election,
