Dear Commissioner Parsons:


You have been requested by a citizen to furnish the most current balance sheet, number of members and name of the president or manager of several credit unions, and you have asked that we consider the request under Section 7 of the Open Records Act [Article 6252-17a, V. T. C. S.].

Section 3(a)(12) excepts from required disclosure:

"information contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions . . . "

We believe the current balance sheet, as reflected on the "Credit Union Annual Report" which you have furnished to us, and the number of members of a credit union are excepted from compelled disclosure by Sec. 3(a)(12); however, we see no reason to withhold the name of a credit union's president or manager.
