Dear Mr. Pogue:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 7751; this decision is OR90-003.

The State Board of Insurance received an open records request for the files on seven agents. Of the material requested, only the Enforcement Section file on Mr. Charles Hines contained information that you feel should not be released. You state that you have released to the requestor all of the information in that file except for one intra-agency memorandum, which you contend is protected from required public disclosure by section 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act. After reviewing the document at issue, this office has concluded that the memorandum at issue does not contain the type of information protected by section 3(a)(11). Consequently, you must release the memorandum in its entirety.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-003.
