Dear Mr. Stuckle:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 7052; this decision is OR90-012.

The Fort Worth Police Department received a request from a prisoner for copies of police reports involving his several arrests. The police department claims that the requested information is excepted from required public disclosure under sections 3(a)(1), 3(a)(3), and 3(a)(8) of the act.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed and reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Attorney General Opinion MW-95 (1979), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. See also our previous determination to you concerning similar information, OR89-403 (copy enclosed). For this reason, you must release the requested information. Future requests of this kind may be resolved by reference to this ruling.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-012.
