Dear Mr. Click:

By letter of February 16, 1988, you submitted an Open Records request from Karen Barnes. Your request was assigned ID# 2979; this is OR90-049.

Ms. Barnes requested data regarding a highway location at which an accident occurred. You have informed us that this matter is presently in litigation. The department believes that this information may be withheld under section 3(a)(3) of article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S., as information related to litigation.

We have considered the exception you claimed and have reviewed the documents at issue. Your request is resolved by a previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 383 (1983), a copy of which is enclosed. You may withhold the requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling, rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-049.
