Dear Ms. Johnson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8030; this decision is OR90-064.


The Gregg County Sheriff's Department received an open records request for a former employee's personnel file. This office has considered the exceptions you claimed and reviewed the records in question. You should withhold the following information:

1. Home address and telephone number of the employee, see Open Records Decision No. 506 (1988);
2. Photographs of the employee, see Open Records Decision No. 502 (1988);
3. Current and prior medications, see Open Records Decision No. 262 (1980);
4. Membership in social organizations, see Shelton v. Tucker, 364 U.S. 479 (1960);
5. Results of polygraph examination, see V.T.C.S. art. 4413(29cc), § 19A.

You must also withhold one other document (marked) that implicates the privacy rights of third persons. The remaining documents must, however, be released.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-064.
