Dear Mr. Power:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8477.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed, specifically section 3(a)(1) and the attorney-client privileges, sections 3(a)(3) and 3(a)(7), and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 399 (1983), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. For this reason, you may withhold the requested information. We need not address exceptions 3(a)(3) and 3(a)(7), since our decision based on Open Records Decision No. 399, regarding section 3(a)(1) and the attorney-client privilege, settles this request.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-098.
