Dear Mr. Finlay:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8546.

The San Antonio Local Development Company, a non-profit corporation created by the City of San Antonio to administer federal loan programs, received an open records request for all records relating to River City Produce Company. You state that all of the requested information has been released to the requestor except for certain financial information that you contend is excepted from required public disclosure by section 3(a)(10) of the Open Records Act.

We have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 309 (1982), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request in part; you may withhold the produce company's financial statements pursuant to section 3(a)(10). You may also withhold all personal financial statements and credit reports pursuant to the common-law privacy aspect of section 3(a)(1). Open Records Decision No. 373 (1983) (copy enclosed).

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter

with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-106.
