Dear Mr. Anderson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8960.

The City of Georgetown received an open records request for a copy of the police department's general order concerning police pursuit. The order provides detailed guidelines to be used by city police officers in responding to calls for service and pursuit of vehicles, as well as radio and reporting procedures.

We have considered the exception to required public disclosure that you claimed, specifically section 3(a)(8), and have reviewed the document at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 531 (1989), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. For this reason, you may withhold the requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-132.
