Dear Ms. Bowling:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8643.

The city of Troy received a request for copies of the declarations pages of all insurance policies the city maintains, containing the name of the insurance company, premiums paid, policy period, deductibles, and policy limits. You seek to withhold the information requested information from required public disclosure under sections 3(a)(1) and 3(a)(4) of the act.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No.75 (1975), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. Cf. Civ. Prac. and Rem. Code § 101.104. For this reason, you must release requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-139.
