
Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 8821.

We have considered the exception you claimed, specifically section 3(a)(3), and have reviewed the documents at issue. Previous determinations of this office, e.g., Open Records Decision No. 454 (1986), a copy of which is enclosed, resolve your request. See also Open Records Decision No. 395 (1983). You have indicated that criminal litigation with respect to the subject matter of the requested information is currently pending. Therefore, you may withhold the requested information. As section 3(a)(3) of the Open Records Act excepts the requested information from public disclosure, we have not considered the applicability, if any, of the other exceptions you claim.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-144.
