Dear Mr. Smith:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 9550.

You have recently submitted to this office documents pertaining to Internal Investigation File No. 231 that you believe to be protected from required public disclosure pursuant to section 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act. We have marked the portions of these documents that you may withhold; the remaining information must be released. In the future, you should submit marked documents when you raise section 3(a)(11).

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-199.
