Dear Mr. Horner:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 9072.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed, specifically, 3(a)(1) and 3(a)(14), and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 332 (1982), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. Exception 3(a)(14) may be used to withhold information which identifies students or parents. Open Records Decision No. 332. Though some of the information relating to student records does not identify students or parents by name, it may be withheld because of the relatively small number of students to which the information could be applicable, making identification of students an easy task. See Open Records Decision No. 294 (1981). We have marked those portions of the letters which should be withheld.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-209.
