Dear Mr. Davis:

You previously asked whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your most recent letter to us was assigned ID# 9813.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed, specifically section 3(a)(1) and 3(a)(2), and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 533 (1989), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. The requested information is deemed confidential neither by statute nor by the common-law right to privacy. For these reasons, you must release the requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-227.
