Dear Mr. Lindley:

By letter of July 2, 1990, you forwarded to us an open records request that the American Educational Complex System received from the Travel Connection. This letter was designated ID# 9988. We responded to your letter by letter of July 23, 1990, and asked that you submit the records requested. We also noted that we understood your letter as seeking to withhold those records under section 3(a)(10) of the the Texas Open Records Act, V.T.C.S. art. 6252-17a. We stated that in order to withhold the records, the American Educational Complex System or the travel agencies in question would have to identify the specific parts of the records you wished to withhold and explain why an Open Records Act exception would be applicable.

Although you supplied the records, you did not offer an explanation in regard to the applicability of any Open Records Act exception. Therefore, you must release the records.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-521.
