
Dear Mr. Nugent:

You ask whether certain information regarding Meridian Oil Transportation, Inc., is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 10522.

We have considered the exception you claimed, specifically section 3(a)(10), and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 541 (1990), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. For this reason, you must withhold sections 4.1, 4.6, 7.1 and 7.2 of the Agreement. The balance of the requested information must be released.

Because prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR91-189.
