The State Board of Insurance received an application under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S., for information related to International Bahamian Insurance Company, Ltd. Your request was assigned ID# 11068.

We have considered the exception you claimed, specifically 3(a)(3), and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 551 (1990), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. For this reason, you may withhold the requested information.
