This letter is in response to your letter dated May 1, 1991 requesting that we reconsider our decision in OR91-181 dated April 16, 1991. Your request for reconsideration was assigned ID# 12368.

OR91-181 concerned the applicability of section 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act to a report commissioned by the City of Austin Electric Utility Department. We have reviewed the portions of the report that we ordered disclosed in OR91-181 and to which you have filed an objection. After reconsideration we conclude that section 3(a)(11) does except from disclosure part of the material that you have asked us to review, and we have marked in yellow those parts on pages 2-25 and 11-8 that you may withhold pursuant to section 3(a)(11). The remaining portions must be disclosed.
