

Dear Mr. Talton:

In your letter of September 16, 1991, which was assigned ID# 13624, you advise that you have received a request to "inspect court records," and that you have asked the requestor to specify the records he wishes to inspect. You correctly point out that records of the judiciary are not subject to the Open Records Act. *See* Open Records Decision No. 274 (1981), copy enclosed.

However, as you have not determined the exact scope of the request, nor submitted documents for our inspection, this matter is not ripe for a determination under section 7 of the Open Records Act. If and when the request is clarified you may seek a decision from this office. If you have questions about this letter, please refer to OR91-467.
