Dear Mr. Sokolow:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned I.D. 12002.

The city of League City received a request for all documents detailing proposals by Race Marketing Associates. You seek to withhold such information under section 3(a)(10) of the Open Records Act, which allows a governmental body to withhold information that would reveal a private party's trade secrets. See Open Records Decision No. 552 (1990). Race Marketing Associates has made a prima facie case that the documents in question contain trade secrets. Therefore, you should withhold the requested documents. *Id.*

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR91-504.
