Dear Chief Windham:

The Fort Worth Police Department (the department) asks whether certain information is subject to public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act (the act), V.T.C.S. art. 6252-17a. Your request was assigned ID# 13769.

The Fort Worth City Manager has received a request for "all documents regarding federal and state law enforcement grant monies received by the City of Fort Worth since 1986." You have told us that the city already has made the majority of the information available to the requestor. You claim that the remainder of the requested information is excepted from public disclosure by subsections 3(a)(1), (2), (3), (8), (11), and (14) of the act.

To secure the protection of section 3(a)(3) of the act, a governmental body must demonstrate that the requested information relates to pending or reasonably anticipated litigation. Open Records Decision No. 551 (1990). You have informed us that the Tarrant County grand jury currently is investigating the conduct of certain police officers in relation to these grant monies. You also have informed us that the grand jury has subpoenaed the same documents the requestor seeks. Based upon this information and upon our examination of the documents you have submitted for our review, we conclude that the requested documents relate to reasonably anticipated litigation in which the officers and the department may be parties. Accordingly, the department may withhold the information under section 3(a)(3) of the act. Because we resolve your request under section 3(a)(3), we need not address the applicability of the other exceptions you claim.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR91-581.
