Dear Ms. Armstrong:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 14765.

You have received a request for copies of records relating to an investigation into alleged misconduct of a Travis County Sheriff's Department employee. You claim that some of the requested information is excepted from required public disclosure by section 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act. We have examined the documents submitted to us for review and have marked the information that may be withheld under section 3(a)(11). The remainder of the requested information must be released.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-53.
