Dear Mr. Hankins:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 14848.


You have received a request for information relating to a Department of Insurance investigation into allegations of unauthorized insurance practice by a specific individual and insurance carrier. You seek to withhold the requested information under sections 3(a)(1), 3(a)(7), and 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act.

We have examined the documents submitted to us for review. We conclude that the information which you claim is excepted under section 3(a)(7) may be withheld in its entirety. See Open Records Decision No. 574 (1990). We have marked the information which may be withheld under section 3(a)(11).

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with

a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-62.
