Dear Mr. Douglas:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 14829.

You have received a request for "a copy of any files in the possession or control of the Department of Public Safety concerning any reports or investigations of a putative quota involving traffic citations in or around Chambers County, Texas, within the calendar years 1990 and 1991." You seek to withhold the requested information under sections 3(a)(8) and 3(a)(11) of the Open Records Act. We have examined the documents submitted to us for review and conclude that they may be withheld under section 3(a)(8). As we resolve this issue under section 3(a)(8), we need not address the applicability of section 3(a)(11) at this time.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with

a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-74.
