Dear Mr. Koehn:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 16114.

The City of West Lake Hills (the city) received an open records request for, *inter alia*, the city attorney's legal opinion concerning the rezoning of a certain tract of land. You seek to withhold this document pursuant to the attorney-client privilege.

We have considered the exception you claimed and have reviewed the document at issue. Previous determinations of this office, Open Records Decision Nos. 574 (1990) and 380 (1983), copies of which are enclosed, resolve your request. The requested information constitutes the city attorney's legal opinion to his client. For this reason, you may withhold the requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with

a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-332.
