Dear Mr. Finley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, V.T.C.S. article 6252-17a. Your request was assigned ID# 16906.

You have received a request for a "diskette copy of all Nocona Hills Property Owners and their addresses from [the Nocona Hills Water Supply Corporation] computer." You claim that section 3(a)(1) of the Open Records Act exempts from required public disclosure some of the information contained on the requested diskette.

You advise us that the requestor was provided a mailing list on self-adhesive labels which reflects, in zip-code order, all Nocona Hills property owners and their addresses. You further advise us that release of this information satisfies his request. Section 7(a) of the Open Records Act requires a governmental body to release requested information or to request a decision from the attorney general. As you have released the requested information to the satisfaction of the requestor, we need not address your assertion at this time that release of some of the information contained on the requested diskette would implicate third-party interests. Accordingly, we are closing this file without a finding.

We are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with

a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-538.
