Dear Ms. Jones:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, chapter 552 of the Government Code (former article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S.).¹ Your request was assigned ID# 20941.

The Waco Police Department (the department) received a request for copies of taped radio and telephone conversations between two named individuals on a specific date. Specifically, the requestor seeks:

- (1) June 9, 1993 conversation via the County dispatch system between McLennan County dispatch and the Deputy Constable of Precinct 8 (conversation occurred between 8:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. on said date); and
- (2) June 9, 1993 telephone conversation between Deputy Posey and the Precinct 8 Constable (conversation occurred between 8:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. on said date).

¹We note that V.T.C.S. article 6252-17a was repealed by the 73d Legislature. Acts 1993, 73d Leg., ch. 268, § 46. The Open Records Act is now codified in the Government Code at chapter 552. *Id.* § 1. The codification of the Open Records Act in the Government Code is a nonsubstantive revision. *Id.* § 47.
