
You ask that we clarify Open Records Letter No. 95-1317 (1995). Your request was assigned ID# 38224.

Open Records Letter No. 95-1317 (1995) determined that the Texas Workers' Compensation Commission ("TWCC") may not withhold from required public disclosure the addresses of four former commissioners pursuant to section 552.103 of the Government Code. The decision also determined that TWCC may withhold the addresses from required public disclosure pursuant to section 552.117 of the Government Code if at the time the TWCC received the request for information the commissioners had elected to not allow public disclosure of their addresses in accordance with section 552.024 of the Government Code.

TWCC received a second request for the addresses of former commissioners and former employees. You ask whether the TWCC may withhold the addresses of two former employees that are the subject of the second request. We now clarify that TWCC may rely on Open Records Letter No. 95-1317 (1995) to withhold the addresses of the two former employees who in accordance with section 552.024 of the Government Code elected to not allow public disclosure of their addresses. Gov't Code § 552.117. We also now clarify that Open Records Letter No. 95-1317 (1995) is applicable to the second ruling in so far as it concluded that the requested information is not excepted from required public disclosure pursuant to section 552.103.

We are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. This ruling is limited to the particular records at issue under the facts presented to us in this request and may not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other records.
