Dear Mr. Calderon:

You have asked this office to reconsider its ruling in Open Records Letter No. 95-635 (1995), concerning whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request for a reconsideration was assigned ID# 34984.

In Open Records Letter No. 95-635 (1995), this office directed you to release to the requestor certain information. It is our understanding that you have released all of the information you were directed to release except for the Office of Professional Standards Investigation Report. You assert that section 552.103(a) of the Open Records Act is applicable to the investigation records because they are the subject of declaratory judgment litigation to which both the district and this office are parties.


As it appears that the trial court's ruling will be controlling in this matter, we conclude that you may withhold the requested information until the trial court issues a decision. Once the trial court rules, you must disseminate the information in accordance with the trial court's decision.

We are resolving this matter with an informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. This ruling is limited to the particular records at issue.
