You ask that this office reconsider our decision in Open Records Letter No. 96-1786 (1996) in regard to the applicability of section 552.107(1) of the Government Code to one sentence on a document you marked #2. Your request for reconsideration was assigned ID# 102796.

We have reviewed the sentence at issue and considered your arguments. We conclude that Open Records Letter No. 96-1786 (1996) is correct in concluding that section 552.107(1) does not apply to the sentence.

We are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. This ruling is limited to the particular records at issue under the facts presented to us in this request and may not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other records.
