Dear Ms. Joseph:

You seek reconsideration of the issues presented under Open Records Letter No. 97-1631 (1997) in asking whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 109528.

In Open Records Letter No. 97-1631 (1997) this office determined that certain information requested by Mr. Gilberto Guerra, Jr. was not excepted from required public disclosure and accordingly instructed your office to release the requested information. Subsequent to the issuance of Open Records Letter No. 97-1631 (1997), you informed this office of extenuating circumstances that you believe warrant the withholding of the requested information.

We have examined the circumstances that you now present to this office and conclude that you may withhold the information at issue pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code. Open Records Decision No. 169 (1977).

We are resolving this matter with an informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. This ruling is limited to the particular records at issue under the facts presented to us in this request and should not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other records.
