Dear Ms. Banks:

You ask this office to reconsider our ruling in Open Records Letter No. 98-0025 (1998). Your request for reconsideration was assigned ID# 115355.

The City of Georgetown (the "city") received a request for "copies of all invoices and payments for Tejas Avionics, Inc. since November 14, 1994." In Open Records Letter No. 98-0025 (1998), this office concluded that the city could not withhold the requested information under sections 552.101, 552.104, and 552.110 of the Government Code. In your request for reconsideration, you re-urge your arguments under sections 552.104 and 552.110.

We have examined the additional documents you sent as well as your arguments for withholding the requested information. We do not believe, however, that the city or Tejas Avionics, Inc., have established the applicability of sections 552.104 and 552.110 to the requested information. We, therefore, affirm Open Records Letter No. 98-0025 (1998). We have also enclosed a copy of Open Records Decision No. 625 (1994), which addresses a similar issue.
