Dear Mr. Hines:

You have asked this office to reconsider Open Records Letter No. 2000-2402 (2000). Your request for a supplemental letter ruling has been assigned ID# 139018.

As of September 1, 1999, governmental bodies are prohibited from requesting reconsideration of open records rulings issued by this office. Gov't Code § 552.301(f). Therefore, this office is not authorized to reconsider the merits of Open Records Letter No. 2000-2402 (2000), and that letter ruling must remain in full effect.

Open Records Letter No. 2000-2402 (2000) explains that the ruling itself triggers certain deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the Office of the Governor and the requestor. This letter does not alter those deadlines, which are still to be calculated from the date that the parties received Open Records Letter No. 2000-2402 (2000).
