The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 255665.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined that your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim that some information you have marked may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the marked information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information. You also claim that the motor vehicle information you marked is excepted from public disclosure pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the Texas license plate number in accordance with section 552.130.
