The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 276893.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined that your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim that the requested proposals and released communications may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.104 of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.104, you may withhold the submitted information. Because you do not object to the release of the requested meeting agenda, council meeting DVD, and resolution passed by the council, we assume you have released such information. *See* Gov't Code §§552.301, .302.
