Dear Ms. Brown:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 295648.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined that your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim that the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. First, you state you will withhold the incident report relating to a pending criminal case based upon the previous determination granted in *Attorney Gen. V. Plano Police Dep't*, No. GV-001919 (126<sup>th</sup> Dist. Ct., Travis County, Texas., December 18, 2000). You further state you will not seek a decision from this office for the incident report. Thus, we do not address the incident report. We have considered your arguments and the rests of the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information.
