The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 341003.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2) you may withhold the submitted CD. The rest of Exhibit B is not responsive to the request, and this decision does not address it. We have received and considered the requestor's comments. We note that under chapter 552 of the Government Code, we are only authorized to decide whether an agency may withhold requested information pursuant to an applicable exception. We are not authorized to review the information for its evidentiary value..
