Dear Ms. Gambini:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 372735.

The City of Irving (the "city") received a request for a specified red light camera video recording. You claim the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides that information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title, or registration issued by a Texas agency is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(1), (2). You state the submitted video recording includes Texas license plate numbers that are subject to section 552.130. You also state that the city lacks the technical capability to redact this information from the video recording. However, upon review, we find that the license plate numbers on the submitted video recording are not discernable to the viewer. We therefore conclude that release of the submitted video recording would not disclose any information subject to section 552.130. Accordingly, the city must release the submitted video recording to the requestor.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
