Dear Ms. Aguilar:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 382053.

The Corpus Christi Police Department (the "department") received a request for offense report number 1003110192. You state the department has released some of the requested information. You claim the marked portion of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.151 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.151 of the Government Code provides:

Information in the custody of a governmental body that relates to an employee or officer of the governmental body is excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if, under the specific circumstances pertaining to the employee or officer, disclosure of the information would subject the employee or officer to a substantial threat of physical harm.


Gov't Code § 552.151. You inform us the information you have marked under section 552.151 relates to an undercover officer assigned to the department's Narcotics/Vice Division. You represent release of this information would subject this undercover officer to a "substantial threat of physical harm." Based on your representation, we conclude you have

demonstrated that release of the information you have marked would subject this officer to a substantial threat of physical harm. Therefore, we conclude the department must withhold the information you have marked under section 552.151 of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
