Dear Mr. Hargrove:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 388183 (PIR No. 10-27955).

The Office of the Attorney General (the "OAG") received a request for communications from January 1, 2008 to the date of the request between the OAG and Carolyn Jessop or an investigator or prosecutorial office. The OAG argues the information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.101 and 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the OAG's claimed exceptions and have reviewed the submitted sample of information.¹

First, we note the submitted information includes a document that is not responsive to the request because it is not a communication between the OAG and Carolyn Jessop or an investigator or prosecutorial office and it was created after the date of the request. Thus, this decision does not address the non-responsive information we have marked.

Section 552.101 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "information considered to be confidential by law, either constitutional, statutory, or by judicial decision." Gov't

Code § 552.101. Section 552.101 encompasses section 261.201 of the Family Code, which provides as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Section 261.203, the following information is confidential, is not subject to public release under [the Act] and may be disclosed only for purposes consistent with this code and applicable federal or state law or under rules adopted by an investigating agency:

(1) a report of alleged or suspected abuse or neglect made under this chapter and the identity of the person making the report; and

(2) except as otherwise provided in this section, the files, reports, records, communications, audiotapes, videotapes, and working papers used or developed in an investigation under this chapter or in providing services as a result of an investigation.

Fam. Code § 261.201(a). The OAG explains the information at issue is developed and used in child abuse investigations and prosecutions. *See id.* § 261.001(1) (defining “abuse” for purposes of chapter 261 of the Family Code); *see also id.* § 101.003(a) (defining “child” for purposes of section 261.201). Thus, we find the requested information is confidential under section 261.201 of the Family Code, and the OAG must withhold the information. Because section 261.201 is dispositive, we do not address the OAG’s other argument.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
