Dear Mr. Mendoza:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 396604.

Your submitted information shows you do not have information responsive to part of the request. Furthermore, the two reports you submitted are not responsive to the request, and this decision does not address them. After reviewing your arguments and the submitted video, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted video.
