Dear Mr. Mann:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 397069.

You have advised the requestor you are unable to locate the 911 calls based on the name of the caller as they are stored by the address from which the call was made. After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the information marked in red may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information marked in red in report numbers 2010R002255, 2009R010576 and 2009R010584. You also claim the information marked in green is excepted from public disclosure pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the information marked in green in report number 2010R013422 in accordance with section 552.130. To the extent the rest of the requested information exists, we assume you have released it. See Gov't Code §§552.301, .302.
