Dear Ms. Sandoval-Walker:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 419857.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim some of the information in submitted report number 11-001176 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold most of the submitted information. However, you must release a detailed description of the offense as basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Also, you must withhold the marked Texas motor vehicle record information under section 552.130 of the Government Code. Lastly, because you have not submitted report number 11-046060 to this office, we assume you have released it to the extent it exists. *See Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.*
