Dear Ms. Bohn:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 414452.

The Lake Travis Independent School District (the "district") received a request for (1) all documents in the requestor's employee folder at human resources; (2) all documents in the requestor's employee folder at transportation; (3) all documents maintained by a named individual in regards to the requestor's employment and job performance at the district; and (4) all e-mails pertaining to the requestor, his employment, and job performance or any other document sent or received by any district or non-district employee pertaining to the requestor's employment or services performed at the district, including e-mails to and from six named individuals. You claim that portions of the submitted information are excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.


Initially, we note that you have only submitted one document for our review. To the extent any additional information existed at the time the district received the request, we assume you have released it. If you have not released such information, you must do so at this time. See Gov't Code §§ 552.301(a), .302; Open Records Decision No. 664 (2000) (noting that if a governmental body concludes that no exceptions apply to the requested information, it must release information as soon as possible under circumstances).

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title, or registration issued by a Texas agency is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(1), (2). Upon review, we agree the district must withhold the vehicle identification numbers we have marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code. As no further exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the remaining information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
