Dear Captain Minton:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 420060.


The Leander Police Department (the "department") received a request for the dash-cam video and arrest report of a specified incident. You state the department has released some of the requested information. You claim the submitted video recordings are excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's license, driver's license, motor vehicle title, or registration issued by a Texas agency is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(1), (2). The submitted video recordings contain audible Texas motor vehicle information. You state the department is unable to redact this information when making a copy of these recordings. Accordingly, based on the department's representation that it is unable to redact the Texas motor vehicle record information from the video recordings, we conclude the department must withhold these recordings in their entirety under section 552.130 of the Government Code. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
