Dear Ms. Debault:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 420641.


The Texas State Technical College (the "college") received a request for an audit report related to specified allegations. You claim the requested information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.103 and 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was created after the date the request was received. Thus, the submitted information is not responsive to the request for information. The college is not required to release non-responsive information in response to this request under the Act, and this ruling will not address that information. Accordingly, we do not address your submitted arguments under the Act. As you have not submitted any responsive information for our review, we assume the college has released it to the requestor, to the extent it existed when the college received the request. If the college has not released any such information, it must do so at this time. *See Gov't Code §§ 552.006, .301, .302; Open Records Decision No. 664 (2000) (if governmental body concludes no exceptions apply to requested information, it must release information as soon as possible).*

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
