The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 429308 (Edinburg Reference #23727).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released report numbers 11-29497 and 11-31729 and claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. However, you must release the basic information, including a detailed description of the offense, pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the marked Texas motor vehicle record information in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code.
