Dear Ms. Villarreal:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 440102 (LGL-11-1410).


The City of Waco (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You claim some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note you seek to withhold telephone number and address of a 9-1-1 caller. In Open Records Letter No. 2011-15629 (2011), this office issued a previous determination to the city authorizing the city to withhold the originating telephone number and address of a 9-1-1 caller furnished to the city by a service supplier established in accordance with chapter 772 of the Health and Safety Code under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 772.318 of the Health and Safety Code without requesting a decision from this office. *See* Gov't Code § 552.301(a); Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (listing elements of second type of previous determination under section 552.301(a) of the Government Code). You state the telephone number and address you have marked are the originating telephone number and address of a 9-1-1 caller furnished by a service supplier established in accordance with chapter 772. As such, the city must withhold the marked telephone number and address in accordance with the previous determination issued to the city in Open Records Letter No. 2011-15629.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
